Letter to the Community

The Shiawassee Community Foundation is pleased to announce its Strategic Plan for 2017 to 2020. As we began our planning process and considered those we serve, it was clear that our community has compelling and important needs that a community foundation is uniquely positioned to address. A primary goal of this plan is to position SCF to play a leadership role in bringing positive changes to the Shiawassee County area. We will accomplish this by increasing awareness of our organization, engaging community partners in important initiatives, and providing funding for priority projects.

This document was created during a series of planning sessions involving a consultant from the Council of Michigan Foundations, our board members, volunteers, and staff. Our hope is that we have developed a focused set of strategies that will strengthen our working relationships with community leaders and grow our grant-making capabilities to better meet community needs.

We are excited by the opportunities this plan presents for our team and the region we serve. You are invited to join us in moving this plan forward.

The four key points of our Strategic Plan are:

- 1. Increase the visibility, awareness, and understanding of our community foundation a. Develop an annual marketing/outreach program
 - b. Develop a next generation website
- 2. Increase revenue available for scholarships, grants, and administrative needs a. Grow our current funds
- b. Raise unrestricted funds for administrative needs and proactive grant-making projects 3. Further develop our board
- a. Recruit board and/or committee members who are comfortable in donor development
 b. Board education
- 4. Become a proactive grant-maker by identifying priority community needs and social issues, encouraging collaboration to address them, and providing funding for these initiatives.

 a. Establish a process to identify priority community needs
 - b. Learn more about proactive grant-making and collaborating

The Shiawassee Community Foundation allows individuals, families and corporations a way to give back in a convenient and cost-effective way. The Foundation currently manages over 100 different funds in which donors may contribute any amount they choose.

The minimum to start a new fund is \$5,000 (a smaller amount will be considered if the fund will reach the minimum value during the first year). Grants and scholarships are awarded after the fund balance has reached \$10,000 and earnings are sufficient. The annual percentage to be spent is approved by the board. Distributions are possible before the fund reaches \$10,000 if gifts are directed to the "spendable" fund balance. To start a new fund, simply contact Carol Soule at 989-725-1093 to discuss your charitable interests.

Some donors choose to leave a legacy by including the Foundation in their estate plan. The Foundation has received bequests that either add to existing funds or start a new fund.

The Foundation was established 43 years ago, more than \$2.6 million has been awarded in grants and scholarships for the benefit of our community. The total assets of the Foundation has grown from approximately \$27,000 to over \$7.4 million today.

We want to thank all of our donors, professional advisors, board members, staff and the many volunteers who have helped us grow over the years. Please consider making a gift to your favorite fund, creating a new fund and/or volunteering to help your Foundation carry out its mission.
