

# Scholarship Application Instructions

## 2019

The Shiawassee Community Foundation's scholarship application cycle opens October 1, 2018 and ends February 1, 2019. Scholarships are awarded annually and can be applied for online. If you are a high school or homeschooled senior, current college student, fifth year early college senior, or non-traditional student, the Shiawassee Community Foundation may have a scholarship for you!

#### <u>To Begin:</u>

- Go to www.shiacf.org
- Click on "Scholarships" at the top of the page, then the "Online Scholarship Application" tab.
- Click "Register," create a login and password, and write it down here:

• Complete all sections of the application: General Information, Academic Information, Financial Information, Qualification Questions, Supporting Information and any Follow-Up Questions that may appear.

#### **Supporting Information:**

Within this section you will be asked to provide:

- **Two letters of recommendation** dated within the last year.
  - > If you have the letter in hand you can simply scan/screenshot the letter and upload it.
  - If you need to request a letter you can do this within the application by typing the person's e-mail address and clicking "send request."
- **High School/College Transcript** <u>All</u> applicants are required to submit a high school transcript. If you have college experience you will also need to submit your most recent college transcript. <u>Transcripts must come directly from the school or institution</u>.
  - To request a transcript, research who the person handling this is at your school. Add the person's e-mail address to the appropriate section of the application and click "send request."
- All documents must be received by February 1, 2019 to be considered for scholarships.

### **Application Tips:**

- This one application allows you to be considered for multiple scholarships. Apply!
- You do not have to complete the application all at once. Your responses automatically save, so you can pick up where you left off any time before the deadline.
- Capitalization, punctuation, and grammar matter.
- Check your e-mail. We will contact you via e-mail if any changes to your application are needed.
